

The panels of the hook system are suspended in a special structure with positive connection and without torsional stress so no tools are needed when removing them for maintenance work

The gaze is drawn to the distinctive triangular perforation of the metal wall system. The repeating triangular motif is interrupted in several areas with fine brass-coloured aluminium cylinders in different lengths. They define artistic highlights and the subtly integrated sprinklers and luminaires do not detract from them in any way.

In the ultra-modern auditorium, eyes are drawn to the acoustics-enhancing hexagonal luminaires that play a defining role in the visual impact of this auditorium.
